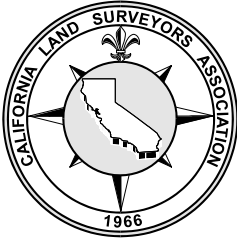
APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS
