

**LAND SURVEY/GEOMATICS ENGINEERING
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Each applicant must submit a complete application package postmarked by the application deadline. The package must include the following:

A **completed** application form.

Attach a brief, yet complete, essay including answers to topics as indicated on the application form. Essay must be typed. **Hand written essays will not be accepted.**

Provide at least one faculty member familiar with students work, including contact information.

Attach a copy of transcripts through May, spring semester, of the year when scholarship award is being applied for.

Incomplete, improperly filled out, and late applications will not be accepted. Valid applications must be postmarked no later than October 15, 2011. **It is the obligation of the applicant to ensure that applications meet the postmarked deadline of October 15, 2011.**

Eligibility

Currently enrolled in an accredited land surveying/survey engineering bachelor degree program, or currently enrolled in an associate degree/certificate program in land surveying or survey engineering with the intent to attend an accredited surveying bachelor degree program or to pursue a career in the Land Surveying profession.

Selection Criteria

The League of California Surveying Organizations Education/Scholarship committee will review and select applicants to receive scholarships annually. Scholarship awards will be determined based upon the applicants' career interests, grade point average, financial need, dedication to the profession of land surveying, land surveying organization affiliation, and geographic location within California. These criteria are inclusive and not necessarily listed in order of selection importance.
